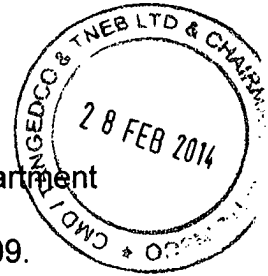

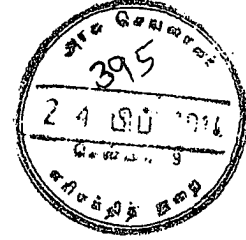

I am directed to state that during the General Elections to Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly held in 2011, the Election Commission of India has given certain instructions regarding modalities to be followed in implementing Model Code of Conduct (MCC) in para 31 of Commission's letter No.464/TN-LA/2011/852-853, dated 21.1.2011. The extract relevant to Model Code of Conduct is as follows:

"31. MCC reference cases shall be sent for views of the Commission through the CEO for resolution. The State Governments will not refer them directly to the CEO. The reference cases must be routed by the departments through the Chief Secretary of the State".

2. All Principal Secretaries / Secretaries to Government may strictly adhere to the instructions given therein by moving proposals through the Chief Secretary for getting views of the Election Commission on Model Code of Conduct matters. The above instructions may also be brought to the notice of all Heads of Departments and other officials under your control for strict adherence during the ensuing General Elections to Lok Sabha, 2014.

I am directed to state that the General Elections to Lok Sabha is due in or before May 2014. With the date of announcement of the General Elections to Lok Sabha, 2014, the Model Code of Conduct will come into force immediately. It is requested that advance action may be taken to ensure that the code is implemented strictly with the announcement of election. Particular attention is invited to the provision relating to ban on advertisement at the cost of public exchequer. Hence, any commodity / product / books / diaries / services, etc. being given by Government having any political messages / pictures / symbols would have to be replaced and ensured that such messages are not carried.

2. You may also ensure that the websites are code compliant on the date of announcement of election, and all references to Ministers, Politicians or Political Parties on the official websites of your and your subordinate departments are taken off / purged of.

3. You are also requested to alert your Heads of Departments and District Officials of the department regarding action to be taken so as to be Model Code complaint with the announcement of election.

Subject: Instructions relating to deletion of all references on politicians/Ministers on the official website during election period of General / Bye-Elections to the Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to state that the Commission has considered the question of various references currently available in the State Government websites/Ministerial official websites pertaining to several Department and Govt. Organization highlighting their achievements but eulogizing the same as personal achievements of Politicians / Ministers. The Commission has decided that during the period when model code of conduct is in force in connection with general election to the Lok Sabha /State Legislative Assemblies, all references to Ministers, Politicians or Political Parties available on such State Government /Central Government 's official websites, shall be taken off/ purged of. During bye-elections, these instructions may be confined to only those Politicians/Ministers, etc. who themselves become candidates at such bye- elections.

This may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.

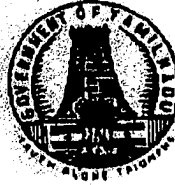
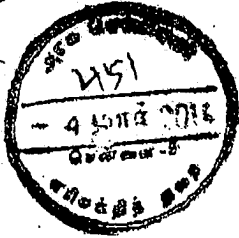
